Summary of what is on offer

All Saints School

The A level Taster Day will be on Tuesday 16 January 2024. This is a full day of lesson tasters when Y11 students will be able to choose four A Level or BTEC options. The day will include a welcome talk by the Head of Sixth Form, experience time in form getting to know other students and a tour of the school site. Archbishop Holgate's School

Archbishops will run full day taster events on both Tuesday 16 and Thursday 18 January 2024. Each day will consist of a welcome from the Director of Sixth Form, followed by a tour of the school and the opportunity to try a number of subjects. After lunch, Year 11 visitors will take part in a Sixth Form tutor session. The day will finish with an individual discussion of potential course options and future career pathways. The York Apprenticeship Hub at City of York Council, along with local employers can help you find out what it's like to do apprenticeship training in York.

What is on offer? There are a few local employers offering a taster (see next page for the application form). However, if there is a particular sector you would like to experience which isn't on the application form, please contact your school's careers lead.

How do I apply? Complete the application form on the next page, save it, and email it to: york.apprenticeships@york.gov.uk by Friday 10 November 2023. Alternatively, take a clear photo of your completed application and send it to the email above.

When is the deadline? Friday 10 November.

When will I find out if I have a place? Tasters are allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. You will be notified as soon as possible if you have been allocated a taster and will then receive further details on timings (i.e., some may be half-days).

What happens on the day? You will receive an introduction, followed by an experience of working and training with that employer. You will get the opportunity to learn about the organisation and different apprenticeships and job roles in that sector.

What do I wear? Please dress appropriately for the type of work, for example:

- construction: clothing you don't mind getting dirty and sturdy shoes
- business/professional: smart clothing
- child care/health care: black clothing and comfortable shoes

Do I need to bring anything? Please ensure you have water, and a pen and paper. Lunch will not be provided unless otherwise stated so please bring a packed-lunch if it is a full-day taster.

How do I get there? You will need to get yourself to the taster location by 8.50am for a 9am start, unless otherwise stated. You will then need to get yourself back home or to school (depending on the time). If you need help finding public transport, contact the York Apprenticeship Hub.
